She is principal investigator in several interventional and non-interventional studies focusing on inflammatory skin disorders. Dr. Luna has also directed courses and preceptorships on Atopic Dermatitis and Co-directs the ECHO-Atopic Dermatitis Argentina group-- a telementoring program aimed to deliver the best clinical practices in AD to underserved areas in Argentina.

Dr. Luna belongs to the board of assessors of ADAR (Argentinean AD advocacy group), is an Associate member of the International Eczema Council (IEC), a member of the IEC's education committee, and directs the fellowship program on inflammatory skin diseases at the Hospital Aleman de Buenos Aires.
